Pennsylvania Life Member Elected Vice President *Ronald Stensland elected to serve National Home Board of Trustees*

Eaton Rapids, Mich. – Comrade Ronald Stensland of Lebanon, Pa. has been elected Vice President of the VFW National Home for Children Board of Trustees. Stensland's election was confirmed during the Annual meeting of Life Members on October 27.

Stensland will assist 2007-2008 Board President Roger Taylor of Grover Hill, Ohio in duties of oversight and policy guidance for the National Home's Board of Trustees. Stensland is the Trustee for District 3 and represents the Departments of Delaware, District of Columbia, Pennsylvania, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Comrade Stensland is a veteran of the Army and served in Korea from 1965-1966. He also served in Vietnam from April 1967 until he was wounded in October 1967 and medically retired in 1969. Stensland joined the VFW in 1970 and became a Life Member of VFW Post #23 in 1986 where he served as Post Commander from 1987-1989. He has been a Life Member of the National Home since 2001 and in 2002, he became the Department of Pennsylvania National Home Chairman, a position he held for two years. Stensland is a Life Member of the Disabled American Veterans LebCo Chapter 81 and a Life Member of the Military Order of the Purple Heart Tri-County Chapter 1983.

"Ever since my first visit to the National Home it has been my personal goal to serve the children. Now, as Vice President, I can do more to make sure all of the children of veterans are cared for," said Stensland.
