National Home Awarded Grant

Eaton Rapids, Mich. – The Capitol Region Community Foundation’s Youth Action Committee has approved a grant in the amount of \$1,800 to the VFW National Home for Children. The grant is to be used for the National Home’s Life Skills Program.

The Life Skills Program provides education, mentoring, and hands-on experiences designed to develop a wide range of skills and to enhance interpersonal relationships. This program teaches youth ages 12 to 22 how to handle real life situations. They have the opportunity to attend themed monthly Life Skills classes or one on one sessions hosted by National Home staff and occasional guest speakers.
